

Monte Vista Fire Protection District Ballot Issue 6A

SHALL MONTE VISTA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY UP TO \$150,000 IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2021 AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS AS MAY BE COLLECTED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL MILL LEVY OF NOT TO EXCEED 1.5 MILLS FOR THE PURPOSES OF MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING THE DISTRICT'S LEVELS OF SERVICE, INCLUDING TRAINING FIREFIGHTERS, KEEPING FIREFIGHTERS SAFE, KEEPING EQUIPMENT IN GOOD WORKING ORDER, AND EDUCATING STUDENTS AND OTHER COMMUNITY MEMBERS ABOUT FIRE SAFETY; SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO INCREASE ITS MILL LEVY BEGINNING IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2022 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER TO OFFSET PROPERTY TAX REFUNDS OR ABATEMENTS OR REDUCTIONS IN THE PERCENTAGE OF ACTUAL VALUATION USED TO DETERMINE ASSESSED VALUATION; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?
