### **Actions as the Board of Health**

At 10:09 AM the Board moved into the Board of Health.

The Board considered renewing the Vaccine for Children Contract and Renewal for the fiscal year 2023. Kolawole Bankole, Public Health Director, reported that this grant goes towards vaccinations, and it has been extended to un-insured (or under insured) citizens. Rio Grande County will be receiving around \$26,000 this year and seven vaccinations will be provided. Commissioner Noffske moved to renew the Vaccine for Children Contract. Commissioner Deacon seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Dr. Bankole said that passing this grant will put Rio Grande County in compliance with the 317 Public Health Service Act providing vaccinations free of charge to people.
